The weather has cooled and the fishing has slowed, but there still are fish being caught. Re-



ports of nice specked trout are consistent throughout the area with the Lynnhaven River being a hot spot. Also, fish are being located around the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnell with catches of Speckled Trout and Stiped Bass. Striped Bass are also being found around the Chesapeake Bay Bridge Tunnell, mostly schoolie sized fish with a few larger in the mix.

If the weather stays relatively mild, it might prove to be a decent winter, but

perhaps an even better fall as the warmer temperatures may provide a nice fishery in 2021. In the cycle of Tidewater fishing it is typically the search for large Striped Bass. Plenty have been found in the middle bay during the Striper tournament. As the Bay closes, the ocean will be bus for another month. Then our attention turns to inspecting our gear and the start of Shad season! Plenty to look forward to, just need to get on the water!
